All artwork MUST be for sale

All artwork MUST conform to the theme and time period of the show reflecting the late 1800's time period of the Chisholm Trail Cattle Drives All work must be original, no workshop pieces

Artwork must not exceed 50" in dimension

All hanging art must be wired, no saw tooth hangers

All stand-alone art will be displayed on a table or a stand, anything requiring a specialized display must be provided by the artist.

Any insurance of the art must be provided by the artist. The Chisholm Trail Art Association and the Tales 'N' Trails Museum will not be responsible for damage

All artwork must be labeled on the back with the artist's information, title of the piece and price of the piece. The Tales 'N' Trails museum will keep 15% of the sale price if the piece sells

Non-Refundable Entry Fees:

Adults: \$35 per entry, limit 2 entries per person per category Under 18: \$10 per entry, limit 2 entries per person. These entries may or may not be for sale however All entries must be accompanied by a check, cashiers check or money order or it will not be accepted
